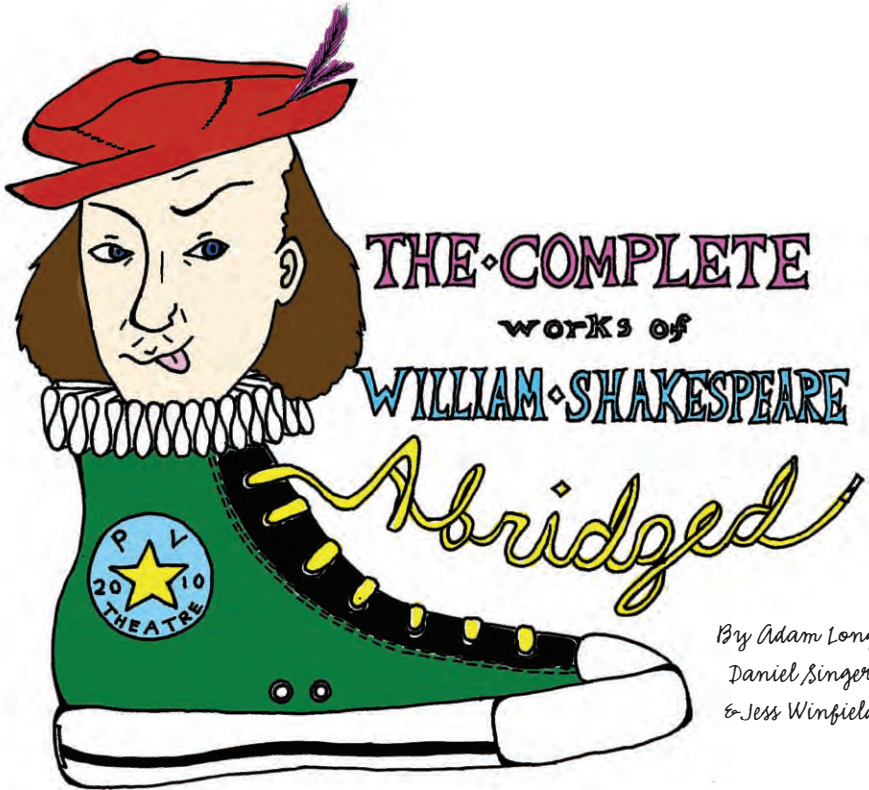

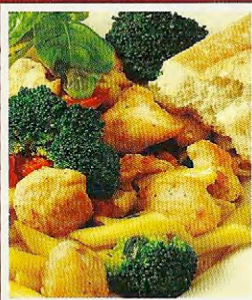

A word from the directors...

WILLIAM SHAKESPEARE. The mere mention of his name can strike fear into the hearts of students or make actors cringe in pain. His lofty language trips up the tongue. His complicated plotlines are harder to follow than an episode of *Lost*. His clever wordplay and lengthy speeches, ripe with imagery and metaphor, present a daunting challenge to our literary minds and theatrical senses. And then there's the mystery of the man himself — even scholars aren't sure of exactly who Shakespeare was! It's no wonder so many people find themselves cowering in fear at the prospect of tackling his work.

Fortunately, we are not thusly afflicted. Though we are in awe of the beauty and power of Shakespeare's words, we approach them without fear! For our friend Will — that genius wordsmith and theatrical master — provided stories, characters, and themes that transcend time and form, and are embodied truthfully, even in the zany renditions you will witness tonight. We are especially proud to present to you these amazingly written versions, first performed by the aptly named Reduced Shakespeare Company, which simultaneously send up and pay homage to every one of the Bard's creations.

This performance does not aspire to preach a message or evoke painful emotions (unless your sides hurt from laughing!) Instead, we find it touching in a very different way. Our interpretation of the Bard's great works may not be worthy of performance in the Globe, but it sure does make us laugh — and no one can say we're afraid of Shakespeare. We hope that after tonight, you can say the same.
