A Word from the Directors

Welcome to Pascack Theatre!

We are thrilled to present the inaugural performance of Pascack Theatre, uniting the talent and passion of Pascack Hills and Pascack Valley High Schools. This ambitious merger required a great deal of planning and the unwavering support of our students, families, and the community. We hope this weekend's performances reflect their dedication to this new venture.

A special thank you to Dr. Sarah Bilotti, Mr. Tim Wieland, and Mr. John Puccio for their visionary leadership. Working through renovation projects in both school auditoriums could have created a difficult situation, but with their support and guidance it has become a beautiful series of opportunities for all of us. We are so grateful.

The original version of *When This Is Over* was created by Company3, a UK-based youth theatre company, as a response to the COVID pandemic. Five sixteen-year-olds shared their stories with one another and their production team, who crafted their script. It had its premiere in 2022.

Our version of *When This Is Over* was created with the input of almost 40 students, aged fourteen to eighteen, whose experience of the pandemic (and all that came before and has happened since) was quite different from the original company's. Our script reflects those differences in its structure, content, and themes, driven entirely by the input of the Pascack Hills and Pascack Valley students' work over weeks of devising. Instead of having a rehearsal process focused on memorizing lines and staging, the company spent a great deal of time generating content. We have played games, done writing exercises, improvised, made and shared presentations, scripted and workshopped scenes, and talked with each other. A whole lot.

The essential, unifying elements of the play—common to the original production and ours—are the questions it explores. *How did we get here, to where we are right now?* and *How do we take on what happens from here?* They take us on a journey across the performers' past, present, and imagined futures. The answer our students arrived at is simple: Together. We got here, and we go forward, together.

Because of this, this play invites the full participation of you, as a member of the audience. When the actors reach out to connect with you—to include you in their stories, their memories, and their visions of what happens when this is over—we hope you will join them on their journeys. It has been a true joy and pleasure for us to do so.
