her time working on this show and hopes to be involved in future shows.

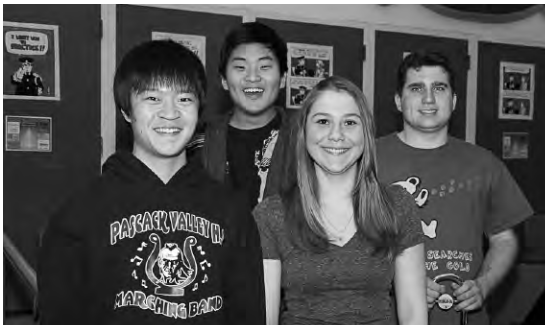
