

A Word from the Directors...

In his 1982 New York Times review of the original off-Broadway production, Frank Rich described *The Dining Room* as "a series of snapshots of a vanishing culture." A mosaic of short scenes that show a wide range of family life throughout the 20th & 21st centuries, the play does depict a way of life that is on the decline, but its fascinating characters are very much alive on our stage.

Parts of *The Dining Room* may seem familiar. Though the play is populated by the upper classes and those who serve them, the situations with which they grapple are universal. Like all of us, these people belong to families. Like all our lives, their lives are full of humor, sorrow, surprises, joy, and heartbreak. And despite the fact that the scenes take place at different times of day, at different times in history, in different dining rooms, another common theme unites them: appearances. This play asks what happens when the appearances we're working to keep up are challenged, threatened, and broken down. When we peek behind the curtain, who is the man standing there?

As a fixture in a home, the dining room had faded in importance—even disappearing in many modern houses, as the walls between kitchen and eating areas have come down. In homes where dining rooms remain, how they are used has drastically changed—some families spend more time around the table doing homework than they do eating a meal. Others find that the entire room is often little more than a depository for extra stuff. As the traditional use of the dining room becomes a relic, the traditions and customs that accompany it fade away as well.

In confronting the realities of modernity, *The Dining Room* asks us to dig below the surface and find a deeper truth. We hope you find our efforts thought-provoking, and that they provide a renewed sense of faith in our shared humanity.
