A Word from the Directors...

Weeks before the Broadway opening of *Anything Goes* in 1934, the show went through a major script rewrite. Originally about the merry adventures of passengers on a transatlantic crossing while a ship sinks, the cruise liner Morro Castle caught fire and sank, with more than one hundred people losing their lives. Facing the possibility of having to close a show before it could open, the producers hired a new team to fashion a new script that kept the ship afloat. The resulting libretto served to connect Cole Porter's amazing score.

Though produced widely now (including three times at Pascack Valley: 1992, 2003 and now), *Anything Goes* was a risqué comedy for its day. In fact, the writing team selected the title, and lyrics to the title song, to mock the 'moral decline' that some people felt America was experiencing. Some things never change.

The show takes place during a time when transatlantic cruises were the only means of travel between the United States and Europe. However, these ships were more than simply transportation—they were extravagant reflections of the sophisticated, smart, glamorous people who filled their passenger lists. These ships welcomed the elite into a world where they could forget their troubles and enjoy the splendor of the seas. We hope that this production offers a similar escape for our audience.
